EDUCATION

Annual Conference

BIAPA coordinates a two-day conference designed for professionals, survivors, family members, caregivers and volunteers. This signature event provides opportunities for professionals, survivors, and caregivers to learn and network and for professionals to earn CEUs. A significant portion of the survivor and caregiver participants are able to attend thanks to scholarships provided by the organization and generous donors.

ReDiscoverU

Established by the Council on Brain Injury (CoBI), the ReDiscoverU Program assists individuals in learning new skills or rediscovering past interests through inclusive and diverse educational opportunities that enhance the health, well-being, and knowledge of those who participate in the classes. Beginning in 2023, BIAPA will host the ReDiscoverU program.

Brain Safety Fairs

Prior to the Covid-19 restrictions BIAPA presented educational and fun-filled Brain Safety Fairs throughout the commonwealth each year. Many events include the fitting and distribution of free bicycle helmets. We hope to begin these programs again in 2023.

Training Services

BIAPA provides a variety of professional educational and training and programs that include: Brain Injury Basics, Certified Brain Injury Specialist (CBIS) Preparation Courses, and Brain Injury 101, 201 & 301. We plan to expand these offerings in 2023.

ADVOCACY

Federal Level: Brain Injury Awareness Day on Capitol Hill

Each March, the Congressional Brain Injury Task Force hosts Brain Injury Awareness Day in Washington, DC to observe Brain Injury Awareness Month. This day is dedicated to educating elected officials about the full range of brain injury's effects, the challenges faced by persons living with brain injury, and the services and supports available to them.

State Level: Brain Injury Coalition

The Brain Injury Association participates in advocacy efforts on behalf of the brain injury community by participating in the Brain Injury Coalition and serving in an advisory capacity on policy issues.

SUPPORT

Brain Injury Resource Line (BIRL) 1-800-444-6443

BIAPA's Brain Injury Resource Line (BIRL) is staffed by volunteers who are able to provide information about resources that may be of help to people with brain injury or their family.

Ambassador Program

Developed through a partnership between the Pennsylvania Department of Health and the Brain Injury Association of Pennsylvania, the Brain Injury Ambassador Program aims to connect with the families and caregivers of a person who has recently experienced a brain injury and let them know that they are not alone: to deliver a message of hope and help.

Support Groups & Social Opportunities

We currently support 25 active support groups across the commonwealth and a national virtual support group. Our annual coordination of Races provide significant social opportunities in addition to fund raising. In January 2023, we will begin hosting a support group for the caregivers of individuals who have experienced brain injury.

Run, walk and roll events, which held throughout the commonwealth, provide significant awareness and social opportunities for participants, in addition to securing financial support for the Association.

School Reentry: BrainSTEPS

After sustaining a brain injury, many students return to school with lingering effects that impact classroom performance. The BrainSTEPS School Re-Entry Program was created by the PA Department of Health in 2007, and is implemented by the Brain Injury Association of PA. is designed to consult with school teams and families in the development and delivery of educational services for students who have experienced any type of acquired brain injury.

NeuroResource Facilitation

This service provides high level planning and care management services for individuals, families, and organizations and connects with both public and private resources systems that will help support the individual with brain injury in the best ways possible over the long term.
